- INTERESTED in becoming a Certified Lay Servant, please complete the application.
- REMINDER to Lay Servants classes are not offered in the fall, so please do not miss this opportunity if you need to meet your 3-year requirement to remain in lay servant ministries.
- ASSIGNMENTS Registrants will receive reading assignments and pre-course work prior to the first class. This work is required to be turned in
 to the instructor on the first day of class and will count toward the 10-hours.
- CANCELLATIONS Baltimore Region may cancel a class for insufficient registrations and will give as much notice as possible for persons to register for another class or request a refund/credit.
- CERTIFICATES Upon successful completion of the class, participants will need to email Darlynn McCrae at darmccrae@aol.com to request the Certificate of Completion and the name that should be printed on the certificate (which will be emailed). Please note: the certificate is only for course completion and does not confirm lay servant status.
- LAY SERVANT MINISTRIES To become a certified lay servant, must complete the basic lay servant class and an approved advanced class during spring training.

 Lay Ministers must complete coursework every 2 years.
