# PROVIDING UNDERSTANDING, SUPPORT AND HEALING FOR CHILDREN EXPERIENCING ADVERSITY AND TRAUMA

This workshop will explore the evidence based research on the long term physical and mental health implications of Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs), toxic stress and trauma. Participants will become knowledgeable about the terminology of childhood trauma, and how trauma impacts social, emotional development.

Instead of adults asking the question, about a child's behavior, "why did they do that?" or "what is wrong with that child" participants will learn the importance of the question, "What happened to the child, what is their story?" The importance of adult "buffers", and trauma responsive healing techniques and strategies will be addressed in this experiential workshop.
