In The United Methodist Church, ordained elders, provisional elders and associate members are part of an itinerant system in which clergy are appointed annually to various mission fields by the Bishop. Through ordination these clergy have agreed to accept itineracy as part of their covenant (¶338, 2016 Book of Discipline). This covenant does not, nor should it, promise to clergy any particular location, size of church, or salary (except that of minimum salary for a full-time appointment).
