

Bible Study Evaluation Full Member Examination

Evaluation Criteria

The total score for the Bible Study is 100 points. A score of 70 or higher is passing.

I. Content This portion of the evaluation is worth 50 points. The score reflects the candidates scholarship and preparation

A. Exegesis/Research

___/15 points 1. The candidate gives evidence of a thorough knowledge of the Biblical text which reflects a graduate study in Bible and Theology.

___/10 points 2. The candidate is able to set the scripture passage in its historical and biblical setting.

B. Life Application

___/10 points 1. The candidate draws analogies to the present for life application.

___/15 points 2. The candidate helps the participants apply the biblical text to their journey of faith as individuals and as members of the community of faith.

II. Presentation This section of the evaluation is worth 40 points. Teaching style, creativity and the presenter's ability to engage the students in the learning process will be evaluated.

A. Teaching Plan

___/20 points The lesson plan includes a variety of teaching techniques in order to bring the text to life in ways that reflect the differences in how people learn (Auditory – hearing information; Visual – seeing the information; Kinesthetic – touching; Participation.)

B. Teacher/Student Interaction

___/20 points The study shows a good balance of presentation by teacher and reflection by the students. The study holds the participants' interest and allows them to reflect on the material. There is good student/teacher rapport. The teacher is able to engage reticent learners and handle those who seek to dominate the conversation.

III Materials *Each candidate is required to include the following materials with his/her submission. Failure to include these items will result in the study being returned to the candidate for re-submission.*

A. Lesson Plan

___/5 points A lesson plan that includes: the learning goals for the session, the information to be covered in each section, the teaching technique for each section and the approximate time for each activity.

B. Video

___/3 points A video of the actual session. The sound and picture quality must be of high enough quality that the session may be adequately evaluated.

C. Bible Study Inventory

___/2 points The required items on the Bible inventory have been supplied by the candidate.
