We are a digital age – people connect on Facebook and Twitter, and now "show me the video" has been the norm. As we work to draw people to church through church websites and Facebook pages, these new visitors come expecting technology. Studies have shown that only 10% of what is said will be remembered, but 50% of the visual media is remembered. In order to share a message, one must at least remember it. This 3-hour free course is designed for churches that either have no media, or have used it only sparingly.
