If possible please include high resolution copies of pictures of the people featured in your story. Please only send high resolution copies of the memorabilia as well since we may not be able to return originals.

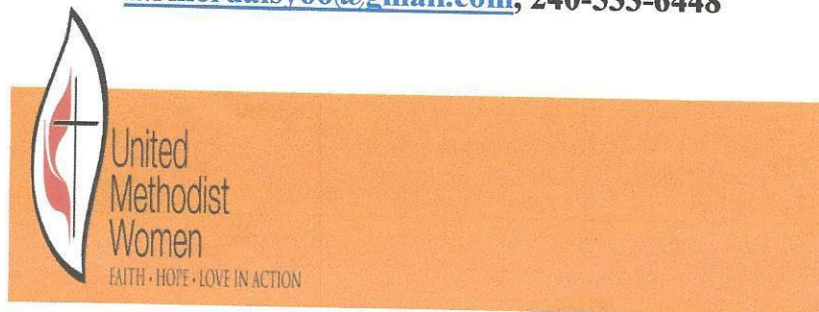
