

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Session Assignments

Session1

Preparation for Session 1: Read the introduction ("The Church, Ministry, and Gifts") on pages 5–7 in Each One a Minister.

After you have read the introduction, note that this session is divided into two parts.

Read Ephesians 1:15-16. Then read "God's Intention for Us" on pages 9–14 in the text. You do not need to complete the exercises as you are reading. Some of the exercises will be part of the class session.

Read Ephesians 2:8-10; 3:9-10; and Galatians 3:23-29. Then read "Prepared for Good Deeds" on pages 15–18 in Each One a Minister and "Sharing the Secret" on pages 19–20.

Complete Spiritual Gifts Inventory—Pray for discernment before starting the inventory- Refer to page 47 in the text to read about discernment and how it is related to gifts discovery.

Session 2

Read Ephesians 4:4-12; Romans 12:4-8; and 1 Corinthians 13:1-3. Then read "Gifted Children" on pages 21–26 in the text.

Read Ephesians 4:23-24; 5:21; 1 Corinthians 12:12-26; and Romans 12:3-5. Then read "The Right Stuff" on pages 27-30 and "Submit to One Another" on pages 31-34 in the text.

Session 3

Read "Spirituality and Practicality" on pages 35–37 in the text and "The Role and Practice of Spirituality" on pages 39–41 in the text.

Session 4

Read "Developing and Deploying the Gifts" on pages 51-55.

Session 5

Read "A Guide for Exploring Areas on Ministry" on pages 57–74 in the text. From the ministry area descriptions on pages 61–74, select at least one area that you would like to be involved in. (You may add a ministry area or activity if you feel it needs to be included.) Read "Discovering Gifts for Ministry" on pages 43–50 in *Each One a Minister*.

Prepare a brief summary of how the ministry activity you have chosen might be put into practice. Be prepared to talk to the group about what you have chosen.
